Allow two hours for a VINZ PPI and the preparation of your PPI Report.


How to book a PPI

What is a VINZ Pre-Purchase Inspection (PPI)?

It's a professional and independent assessment of a vehicle's mechanical and structural condition and appearance, to help you buy or sell a used light vehicle.

A VINZ Warrant of Fitness (WoF) approved Inspector will inspect your vehicle and email you a full PPI Report.

Our PPI Report tells you all the items we've checked and provides an overview of the vehicle's condition and appearance at the time of the inspection. This includes comments on potential WoF defects and faults that may require attention.

What does a VINZ PPI include?

We check the following items:

- Steering, brakes and car handling - we test-drive.
- Engine - any noise, fumes or smoke?
- Battery and alternator - condition and operation.
- Exterior of the radiator, water pump and hoses - condition, including leaks.
- Wheels and tyre tread depth - any damage?
- Suspension - any damage, leaks or wear?
- Lights and radio - are they working?
- Exterior of the vehicle - any dents, corrosion or damage?
- Interior of the vehicle - any damage, wear and tear or stains?
- Car jack, wheel brace, spare wheel and tool kit check.

Why obtain a VINZ PPI?

Buying a used car is often a significant purchase and can be risky and daunting, particularly if you have limited mechanical knowledge.

A VINZ PPI makes the process of buying or selling a used vehicle easier.

By obtaining an independent assessment you have more information to help you decide whether to buy a used vehicle or not.
